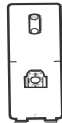

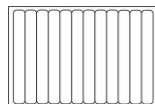

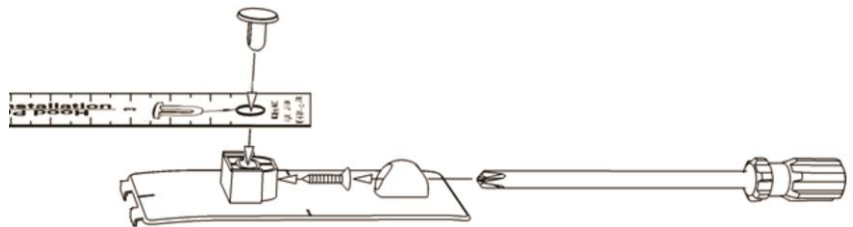

## INSTALLATION

- Make sure the vehicle is clean and completely dry before installation.
- This product uses a 3M adhesive product that requires installation and curing temperatures of at least 20°C/ 70°F for 24 hours to develop maximum adhesion to the surface. Failure to install this product at the proper temperature or allow adequate curing time before use is not covered under warranty.
- Proper installation of the adhesive pedestal system requires the use of a #2 Phillips screwdriver, preferably with a long shaft. The shaft of the screwdriver needs to fit through the hole in the pedestal. Use of the correct screw driver will facilitate a trouble free installation. Do not attempt to use #1 or smaller Phillips screwdriver or any type of electric screwdriver.



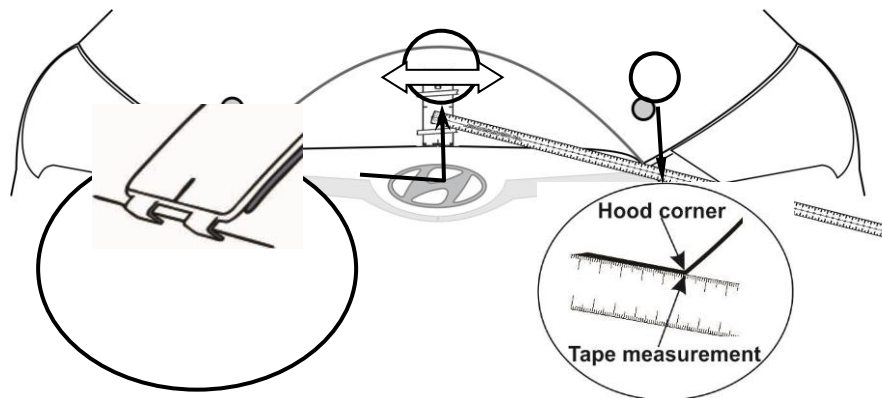
1. Insert a pin through the hole in the Hood Protector Installation Tape supplied and into one of the large adhesive pedestals.
2. Install one of the #6 x 5/8 flat head screws into the pedestal.

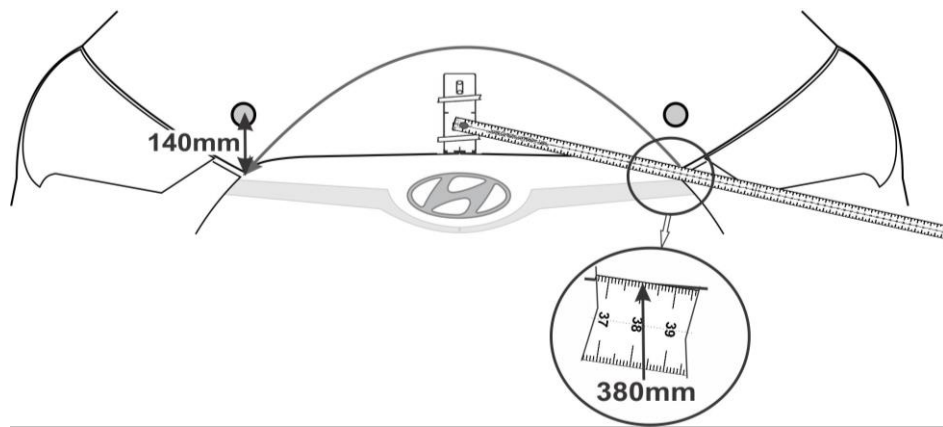


### Locate centre pedestal using installation tape.

3. Estimate the centre of the hood and using masking tape or the repositionable tape strips supplied, tape the pedestal into position.
- Use the installation tape to confirm centre by measuring two opposite corners of the hood and adjust pedestal until both measurements are identical.

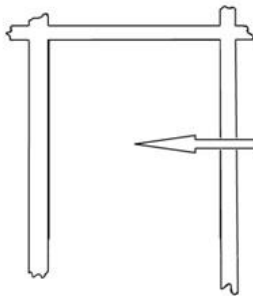
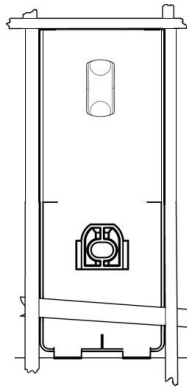
**NOTE:** The fingers incorporated on the leading edge of the pedestal will help ensure the correct position relative to the hood edge. When correctly positioned the fingers should contact the leading edge of hood



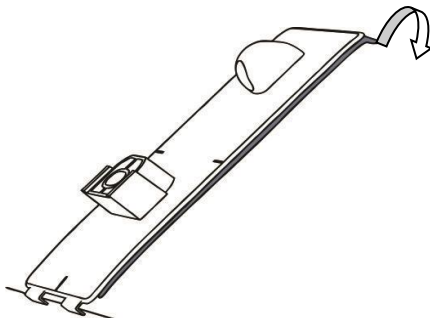


**Locate bumpers using installation tape.**

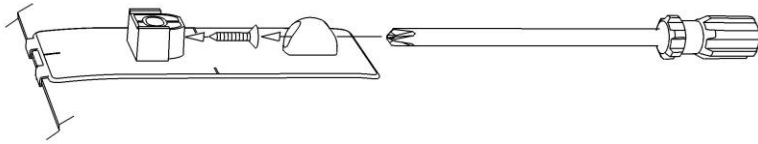
4. Install the two (2) bumpers as shown. **Attention:** Bumpers must be installed on the hood, not on the deflector. If the bumpers are installed on the deflector, they may wear through the paint.



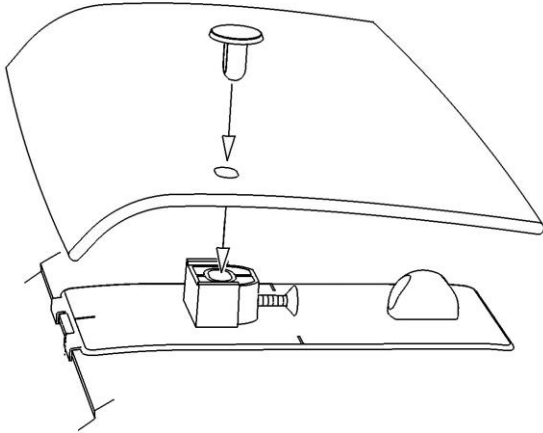
6. Remove the pedestals and thoroughly clean the outlined area with the alcohol wiping pad. This will insure all wax, finger prints and oils are removed from the hood surface in the bonding area.



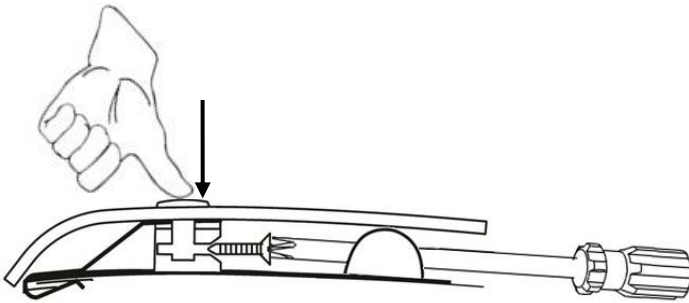
7. Remove the protective backing film from each of the adhesive pedestals and install them on the hood surface.  
**Tip:** Hook the fingers on the pedestal over the hood edge and rotate the unit into position. After installation, remove the masking tape and "wet out" the pedestal base by applying pressure with your thumb around the surface of the pedestals.



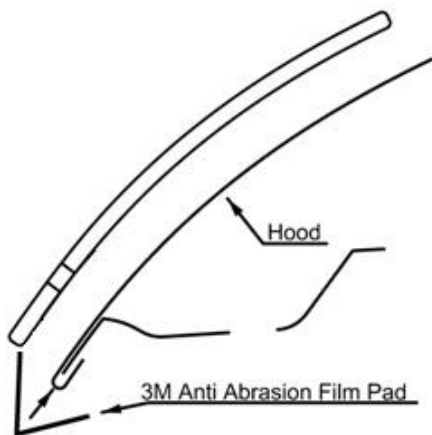
8. Start a #6 x 5/8 flat head screw into each pedestal a few turns. The tip of the screw must not protrude into the hole where the attachment pin will install later.



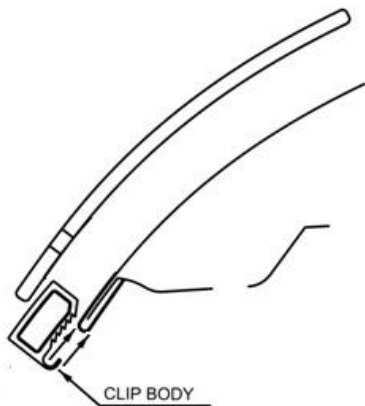
9. Place the deflector on the pedestals and drop a pin through the deflector and into the pedestal.



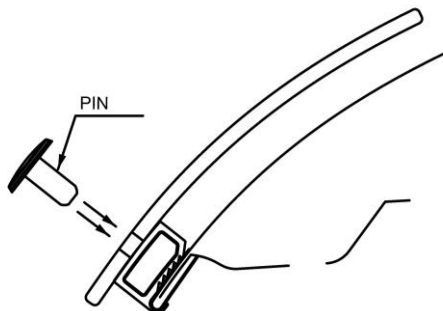
10. Maintain slight pressure on the pin, to ensure proper seating of the components, while simultaneously tightening the screw. Repeat for remaining pedestal locations.



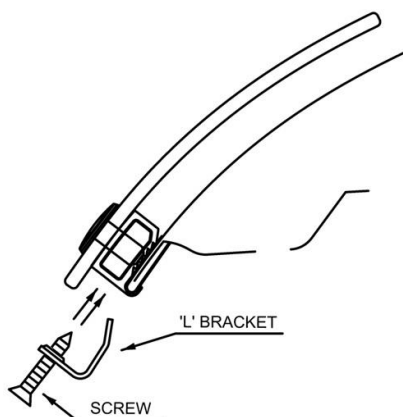
11. Peel and fold the four (4) large anti-abrasion film pads in half over the hood edge aligned with the outer holes of the deflector in the area above the headlights.



12. Place a clip body over each of the anti-abrasion film pads on the edge of the hood.

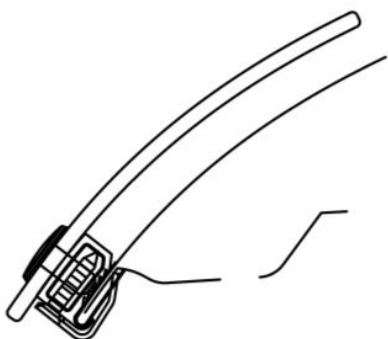


13. Insert a pin through the protector into each of the clip bodies.



14. Insert a #6 x 5/8" screw through an 'L'- bracket and into the clip body.

15. Make sure all the components are well seated together and then tighten the screws into the clip bodies.



#### CARE

- Hand clean the deflector using a mild soap and water solution or plastic cleaner only.
- Avoid automatic car-wash equipment where a brush and/or soft cloth come in contact with the hood deflector. Touch-less style automatic car-wash equipment is less likely to harm the air deflector.
- Periodically check to confirm the deflector is securely attached to the hood.

#### WARNINGS

- Do not pull/push on the deflector when opening/ closing the hood.
